
Strathmore West Developments is owned by the same ownership group behind the De Havilland Field aircraft manufacturing site in Wheatland County.













About the Area Structure Plan




What is an ASP?

An Area Structure Plan (ASP) is a long-range planning document and is the first step in obtaining planning approval for a new community.


An ASP gives direction for more detailed subsequent planning stages such as Land Use Amendment and Subdivision applications.

Location






Strathmore West is located on the western edge of the Town of Strathmore. It is south of Township Road 244, west of Wildflower Road, east of Range Road 254 and is approximately 1.0km north of Township Road 242/Highway 1.

The site's location provides access to:

- Developing communities of Lakewood Meadows & Wildflower Ranch.
- + Existing amenities.
- → Regional transportation networks, including Highway 1.
- + Local and regional employment opportunities.

ASP Concept



ASP Concept





Open Space






Open space destinations across the Plan Area are to support healthy lifestyles through diverse programming and the incorporation of pathways and trails.


To achieve this, the envisioned open space system is anticipated to include:

- + Local Parks.
- + Schools.
- + Crown Claimed Wetlands.
- Western Irrigation District Canal.
- + Well Setbacks.
- + Pipeline Rights-of-way.
- + Drainage Courses.



Transportation






The street network for the Plan Area will integrate with the existing and future transportation network of the Town as identified in the Transportation Master Plan.

A Transportation Impact Assessment (TIA) was prepared in support of the Area Structure Plan and includes a series of recommendations to ensure the safe and efficient flow of people and goods through the new community.


Active Transportation






The Plan will support walking and cycling through the provision of sidewalks, multi-use pathways and trails.

Multi-use pathways within road rights-of-way will connect to pathways within the Environmental Study Area, the pipeline rights-of-way and the irrigation canal setbacks to create a comprehensive multi-modal transportation network.




Servicing






Water, wastewater and stormwater management strategies will follow the Town's Master Servicing Studies, informing capacities at full-build out.

- + Water servicing will be supplied by the East Calgary Regional Waterline (ECRL); ties into Wildflower Reservoir.
- + Wastewater servicing will be supported by the Town's existing Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and its established Central Trunk System.
- + Stormwater runoff will be drained into a series of four ponds before being discharged into the Co-operative Stormwater Management Initiative (CSMI) regional drainage system.




Phasing





Strathmore West is anticipated to be developed in eight phases, starting from the southern-most parcels.

The order of development is based on access to current Town services and logical sequence within the context of the existing Town.
